EMERGENCY



FIRST AID

Swallowed:

Give milk or water (if conscious). INDUCE VOMITING. Medical attention.
 Do NOT give milk or oil.
 Do NOT give alcohol.

Eye:

Wash with running water (15 mins). Medical attention.

Skin:

Wipe-off with clean/dry cloth. Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with water & soap. MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Inhaled:

Fresh air. Rest, keep warm. If breath shallow, give oxygen. Medical attention.

Advice To Doctor:

Evaluate for respiratory distress. Consider lavage with cuffed tube. NO adrenalin.
 Decontaminate with ipecac or lavage. Ethanol therapy.

Fire Fighting:

Keep containers cool.
 Foam.

Spills and Disposal:

Eliminate ignition sources.
 Consider evacuation.
 Prevent from entering drains.
 Contain spillage by any means.
 Absorb with dry agent.
 Stop leak if safe to do so.
