EMERGENCY

FIRST AID

Inhaled:	Fresh air. Rest, keep warm. If breathing shallow, give oxygen. Medical attention.
Advice To Doctor:	Treat symptomatically. Evaluate for respiratory distress. Consider lavage with cuffed tube. NO adrenalin.
Fire Fighting:	Foam.
Spills and Disposal:	Eliminate ignition sources. Prevent from entering drains. Contain spillage by any means. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and detergent.
